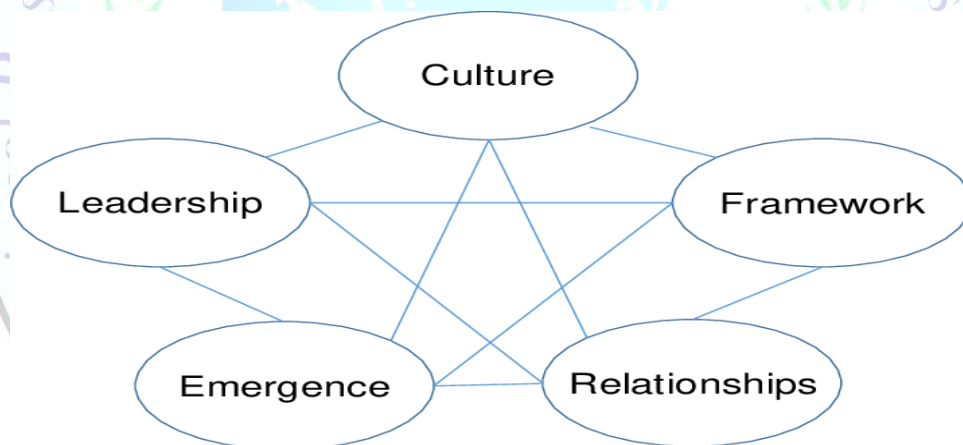


Figure: Success Factors for Viable Sustainable Development
